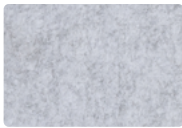
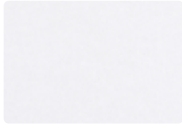
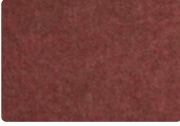
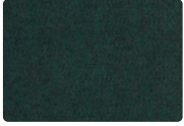
PET Felt

The ground-up bottles are transformed into fibres, forming a soft yet sturdy felt with an open-cellular structure. This gives the material excellent acoustic properties, making it naturally sound-absorbing. PET Felt is easy to maintain, impact-resistant and fully recyclable.

Colour variations

Slight colour variations are a natural result of using recycled fibres in PET Felt panels. Each panel has a front and a back side, as the fibre nap runs in a specific direction on each surface. For a consistent finish, always install the panels with the front side facing out, and align them in the same direction throughout.
